Because of the ongoing federal government shutdown, there is uncertainty about the **Supplemental Nutrition Assistance Program (SNAP)** benefits and other supports. Since many schools will be closed for some or all of next week, free school meals may not be accessible. Please review and share State resources with families who may need help.

#### New Jersey's Supplemental Nutrition Assistance Program (SNAP)

This situation continues to change, so **SNAP food assistance recipients** should **check their accounts at NJFamiliesFirst.com**; call **800-997-3333**; and visit **njsnap.gov** for updates.



New Jersey was notified by the federal government that November SNAP benefits will not be available on time if the federal government shutdown continues.

SNAP benefits loaded onto Families First EBT cards before October 31 will be available for use after November 1.

We encourage SNAP food assistance recipients to check their account at **NJFamiliesFirst.com** or by calling **800 997-3333** before going to the grocery store after November 1. If there are SNAP benefits in your NJ FamiliesFirst account, they are available for you to use.
